WordPress releases a new version. They are aimed to provide safety and convenience during the updating process and to avoid the most common issues.

Create backups

We can hardly predict the consequences of the update. The best possible option is when the website brings up to date successfully. Unfortunately, sometimes it doesn't happen. may break down after updating. In the most optimistic scenario, they stop working and nothing else happens. It's the best option because you can shut them down and wait until the new version will provide the required compatibility. It may cut the functionality of your website but won't hurt its stability.

The other deal is the situation when plugin remains online but starts to work incorrectly. It may be hard to find out that something has gone wrong with a particular tool. Its functionality may become unstable or distorting and lead to severe performance issues, including security problems.
